

NAME

CURLOPT_NETRC_FILE – file name to read .netrc info from

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_NETRC_FILE, char *file);
```

DESCRIPTION

Pass a char * as parameter, pointing to a zero terminated string containing the full path name to the *file* you want libcurl to use as .netrc file. If this option is omitted, and *CURLOPT_NETRC(3)* is set, libcurl will attempt to find a .netrc file in the current user's home directory.

RETURN VALUE

Returns CURLE_OK if the option is supported, CURLE_UNKNOWN_OPTION if not, or CURLE_OUT_OF_MEMORY if there was insufficient heap space.
